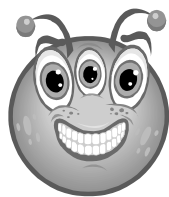

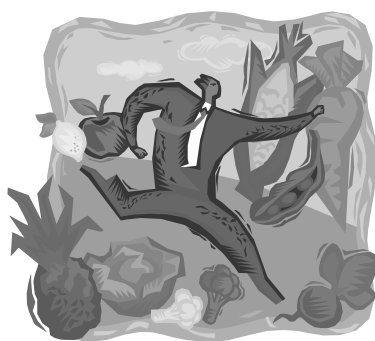
What is causing this appalling reaction?

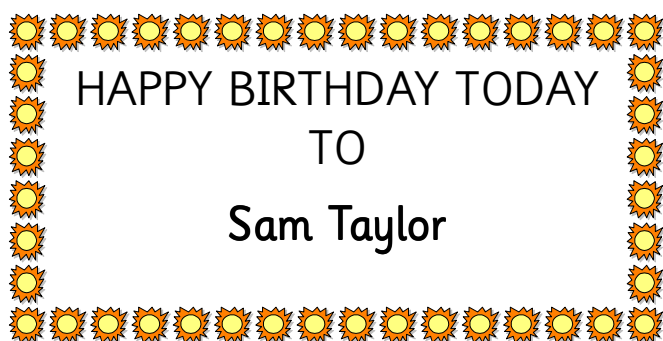
